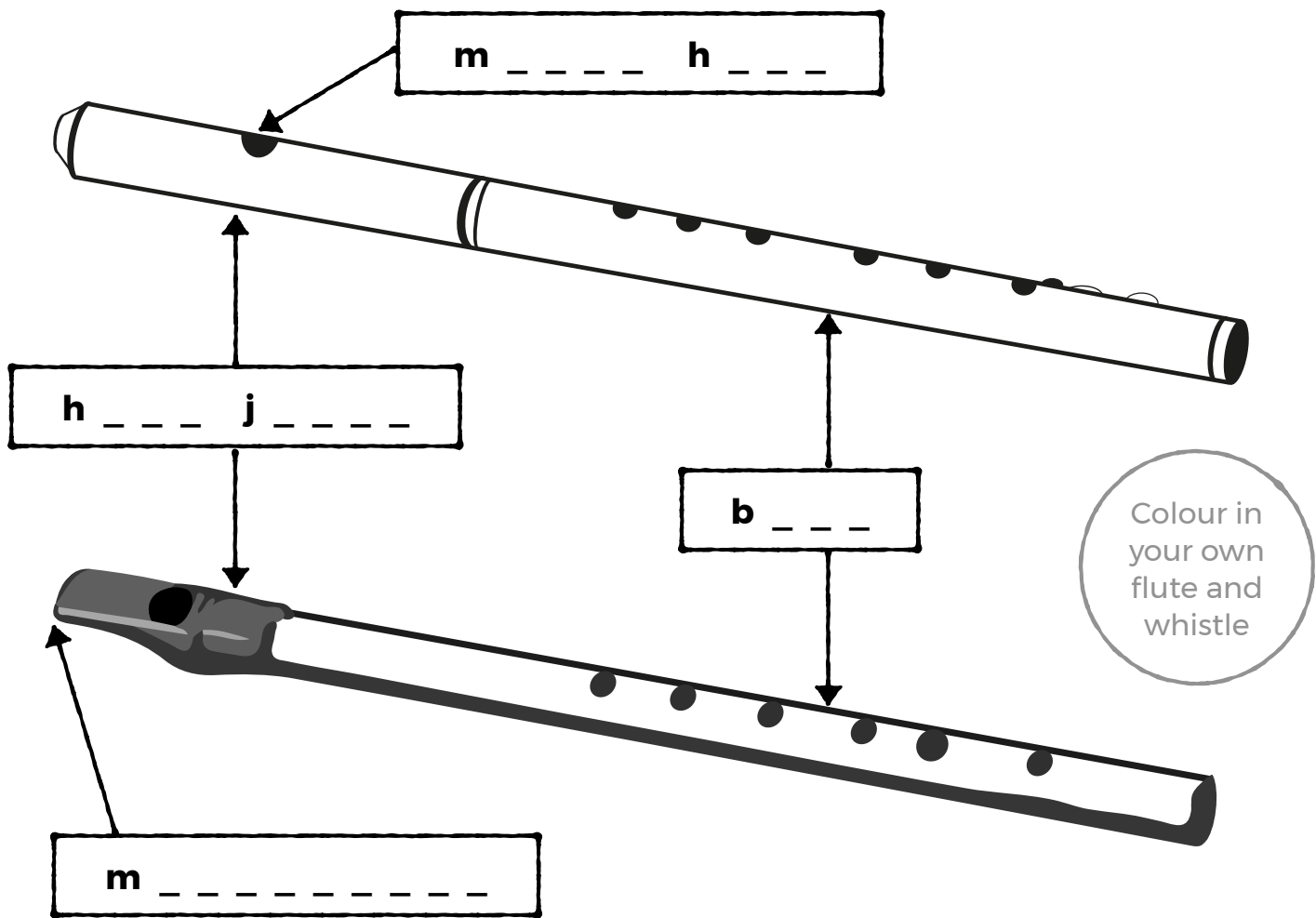


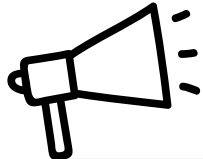
Duiseal agus Fìdeag // Flute and Whistle

They share a number of parts - how many can you name?

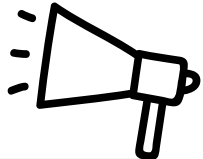


The flute and whistle
