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Fèis Phàislig Weekly Lessons

Positions: **Fiddle Tutor (1 year), Guitar Tutor (1 year)**

Fèis Phàislig was established in November 2014 to provide traditional music opportunities for young people in Renfrewshire. We now offer a year-round programme of events including our weekly instrumental lessons in accordion, fiddle and guitar. Participants currently receive a mix of online lessons and in-person tuition at Castlehead High School, Paisley.

We are currently seeking two part-time hourly paid tutors for tuition in **fiddle** and **guitar**. Applicants must be available to deliver tuition across all Saturday mornings during term time. A list of term dates for the remaining 2021/22 session is available at the end of this document.

Job Description: Specific tasks

Our weekly lessons programme will deliver an inspiring and engaging experience of traditional music for our participants, with a number of performance opportunities throughout the year. Successful applicants will be required to carry out the following tasks:

1. Plan and deliver weekly instrumental lessons during school term-time.
2. Deliver, in conjunction with the wider Fèis Phàislig tutor team, weekly instrumental classes, music theory (grade 1) and mixed instrument groupwork classes when teaching in-person (every third Saturday).
3. Lessons are delivered in English however tutors must be comfortable using Gaelic within their lessons. Support can be provided by the Fèis for this if necessary.

Priority may given to applicants who can demonstrate their dedication to learning Gaelic / are already fluent.

4. Follow and implement Fèis Phàislig's Child Protection Policy at all Fèis events, including upholding a duty of care to class participants.
5. Maintain simple records in order to track class participants' progress i.e. practice diaries.
6. Regularly liaise with participant parents/guardians to keep them informed on updates and session information.
7. Attend to all reasonable matters that are required to ensure the success of the project.
