Our Gaelic Choir programme will deliver an inspiring and engaging experience of Gaelic song for our participants, with a number of performance opportunities throughout the year. Successful applicants will be required to carry out the following tasks:

1. Plan and deliver weekly choir sessions during school term-time.
2. Follow and implement Fèis Phàislig's Child Protection Policy at all Fèis events, including upholding a duty of care to class participants.
3. Maintain simple records in order to track choir progress.
4. Regularly liaise with participant parents/guardians to keep them informed on updates and session information.

5. Attend to all reasonable matters that are required to ensure the success of the project.

The Royal National Mòd will return to Paisley in October 2023 and it is our hope to have a choir that can participate in the event at that time. An understand of the Mòd and ability to prepare the choir for local and national competitions would be favourable.
