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### **Fèis Phàislig Music Workshops (ASN Schools)**

Position: **Music Tutor**

Rate: **£38.50 p/h + reasonable travel expenses**

Fèis Phàislig was established in November 2014 to provide traditional music opportunities for young people in Renfrewshire. We now offer a year-round programme of events, including our new project in Renfrewshire ASN schools, which will take place during term-time.

We are currently seeking a Fèis Phàislig tutor to pilot a block of 8 introductory sessions for young people aged 10-17. The delivery day is flexible but may be limited depending on prior school commitments. Sessions will take place at Riverbrae School, Linwood and Mary Russell School, Paisley. The workshops will allow participants to experience different elements of the Fèis, including traditional music, song and dance. The successful applicant must be available to deliver tuition across all days specified above.

### **Tuairisgeul obrach // Job Description: Specific tasks**

Our Fèis Phàislig sessions will deliver an inspiring and fun experience of traditional music and Gaelic for our participants. Tutors should be able to demonstrate a sound understanding of the skills required to work in an ASN setting, with a commitment to inclusive practice. An ability to use Gaelic in lessons would also be desirable, although support can be given to candidates from other backgrounds. An ability to work flexibly and creatively with large groups is essential. It is anticipated that sessions will involve both sung and instrumental content.

Successful applicants will be required to carry out the following tasks:

1. Plan and deliver an 8-week block of traditional music / Gaelic song sessions.

2. Follow and implement Fèis Phàislig's Child Protection Policy at all Fèis events, including upholding a duty of care to class participants.
3. Maintain simple records.
4. Regularly liaise with participant parents/guardians to keep them informed on updates and session information.
5. Attend to all reasonable matters that are required to ensure the success of the project.
